Shigeru Kohno, M.D., Ph.D., received his M.D. and Ph.D. degrees from Nagasaki University School of Medicine in Nagasaki, Japan in 1974 and 1980, respectively. He joined the Department of Pathology, University of New Mexico, U.S.A. as a research associate from 1980 to 1982, and National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland, U.S.A. as a visiting scientist between 1993 and 1994. In 1996, he became Professor of 2nd Dept. of Internal Medicine, Nagasaki University School of Medicine, and promoted to Chairman of Graduate School of Medical Sciences and also Dean of Nagasaki University School of Medicine in 2000 and 2006, respectively. From April of 2009, he started to serve as Trustee of Nagasaki University and Director of Nagasaki University Hospital. His major research interests are focused on fungal and bacterial infections and have developed several clinical guidelines of respiratory infections including pneumonia and fungal infection in Japan.
