- **Big Island** (808-935-1206) 300 survival kits available: **Friday January 5, 2007:** Hilo Shopping Center: Corner of Kilauea and Kekuanoa Street on the mauka side of the First Hawaiian Bank (Across from Happy Valley Seafood Restaurant).
- **Kauai** (808-245-4142) 100 survival kits available: **Friday January 5, 2007:** Kukui Grove Shopping Center Parking Lot
- **Maui** (808-244-5110) 100 survival kits available: **Friday January 5, 2007:** Kaa`ahumanu Mall
